In this context students share life experiences within the programme, school and community that encourage the core values of quality work and excellence through the daily practice of manaakitanga, whanaungatanga and kotahitanga. The use of te reo Māori is encouraged and developed within the programme with all students taking te reo Māori as their option subject for half a year.
