STEP TWO: Interviews

Parents/caregivers and students make an appointment to see the Year 9 Deans in the Trident Library. Please go to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz and use x67ps to make an appointment via online. Alternatively please phone the school office (308 8159) to make the appointment.

Please bring the photocopy of birth certificate or passport (we can photocopy this for you). The Year 9 Deans and Assistant Principal Ms Ginny Bellamy will conduct the interviews and answer any queries about Trident.

Interviews will take place from 3.15-5.30pm Monday–Thursday; 9am-3pm Friday.

STEP THREE:

Enrolment confirmation

All students residing with parents or primary caregivers or legal guardians in the Trident zone are automatically eligible to attend Trident.

Out of Zone application information

Students residing with parents, caregivers or legal guardians outside the Trident High School Zone are considered to be out-of-zone. Dependent on the number of students enrolling for 2020 the THS BOT will recommend the number of out-of-zone students who will be able to attend through a ballot process.

The Enrolment Scheme and associated Zone directed by the Ministry of Education continues for 2020. A copy of the scheme is enclosed, as well as a map and description of the zone on the back of that page. On the Application to Enrol form you must indicate whether it is an in-zone or out-of-zone enrolment. If it is an out-of-zone-application you must also indicate which category you wish to enrol in (see right for categories).

NOTE: Legislation requires the selection to be carried out by ballot. See below for ballot categories, categories are in order of preference.

Category 1	Special Programmes – Trident does not offer a special programme
Category 2	Applicants who are siblings of current students
Category 3	Applicants who are siblings of former students
Category 4	Applicants who are children of former students.
Category 5	Applicants who are children of board employees or board members
Category 6	All other applicants
