The position begins 28 January, 2022 to 27 January 2023 and is a Fixed Term position. ***The reason this position being fixed term and not permanent is because the provisional staffing notice indicates the board's staffing is above our entitlement based on predicted roll for 2022. Therefore, the board is unable to permanently appoint without MoE approval.***

The position involves teaching Whakairo Carving with a knowledge of Maori Tikana and teaching Maori Performing Arts to students at Year 9 to NCEA Level 3.

The results achieved by students are excellent and come from a commitment by staff. There is an expectation that the team will do the extra to ensure students achieve as close to their potential as possible.
